

## **COLONEL G. HEATH ALLEN**

Colonel G. Heath Allen is the 147th Mission Support Group Commander, Ellington Field Joint Reserve Base, Houston, Texas. He leads more than 600 Airmen to provide full-spectrum mission support. He is responsible for organizing, training, and equipping combat-ready forces for rapid deployment in wartime missions in support of Joint Terminal Attack, MQ-9 Reaper, Surveillance and Reconnaissance, and Expeditionary Combat Support missions as well as domestic operations in times of state or national emergency. The 147th Mission Support Group is comprised of six squadrons and two flights, including the 147th Civil Engineer Squadron, 147th Communications Squadron, 147th Force Support Squadron, 147th Logistics Readiness Squadron, 147th Security Forces Squadron, 272d Engineering Installation Squadron, 147th Contracting Flight and 147th Recruiting and Retention Flight.

Colonel Allen enlisted in the Air Force as an F-16 Crew Chief in 1997. He graduated from the Academy of Military Science, McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base, Tennessee in 2003, commissioning as 188th Wing Chief of Public Affairs. In this role, he was also the Arkansas National Guard Deputy State Public Affairs Officer in 2010 and deployed to Ali Al Salem Air Base, Kuwait, in 2010-2011 as Chief of Public Affairs, 386th Air



Expeditionary Wing. Colonel Allen later served as 188th Wing Executive Officer for four years, functioning as lead Spokesperson, Protocol Officer, Legislative Liaison, and Sexual Assault Response Coordinator. He commanded the 188th Security Forces Squadron for over six years, also serving as Defense Force Commander, Antiterrorism Officer, and Mission Assurance Coordinator. In this position, he was also the Arkansas National Guard Quick Reaction Force Commander, leading a joint domestic operations unit of 120 Airmen and Soldiers in civil disturbance response support to civilian law enforcement agencies. He later served as Deputy Chief, Operations and Training Division, Headquarters Air Force, Pentagon, Washington, District of Columbia, and Security Forces Liaison, National Guard Bureau, Air National Guard Readiness Center, Andrews Air Force Base, Maryland. Prior to his current assignment, he was Deputy Chief, Director's Action Group, Office of the Director of the Air National Guard, Pentagon, Washington, District of Columbia. In this role, he led a team of nine strategists, developing and directing strategic engagement initiatives with Congressional audiences and Department of Defense senior leaders to meet National Defense Strategy objectives.
